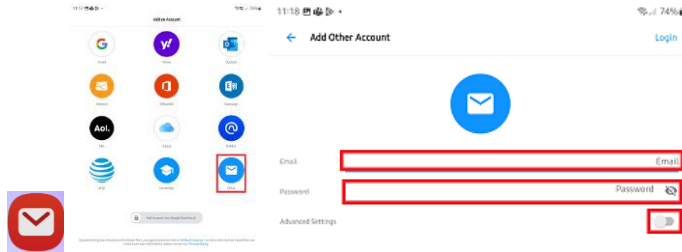

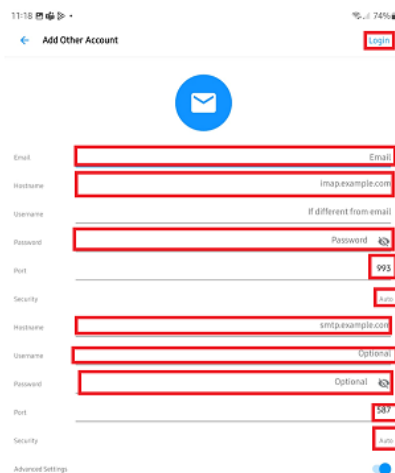

Samsung Mail - Manual setup

1. Tap Email app > Add an Account > Other > Enter Email Address and Password > Select "Advanced settings Toggle" > Tap Login



2. Enter the below settings for incoming/outgoing servers > Tap "Login".

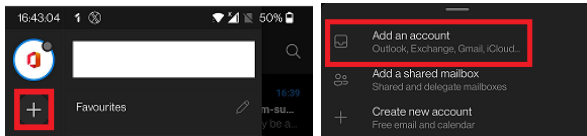

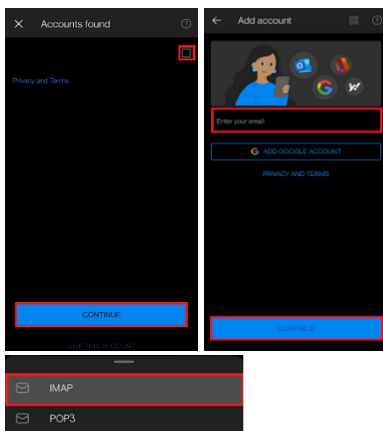

1. If you are opening Outlook for Android for the first time enter your email address > Tap continue or slide out the side menu on the left > Tap the plus symbol > Add an account.

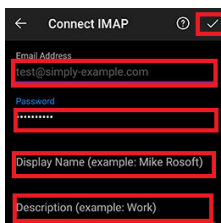


2. Untick any accounts found > Tap "Continue" > Enter your email address > Tap "Continue" > Select "IMAP".



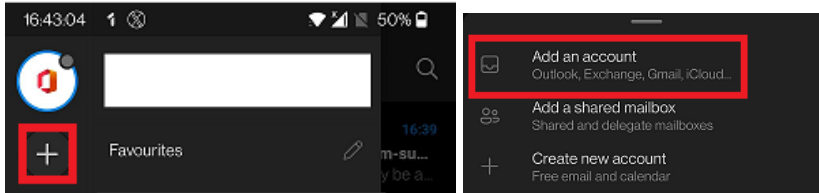
3. Enter the below details then tap on the tick.

- **Description:** Input a description of your account, e.g., Work.

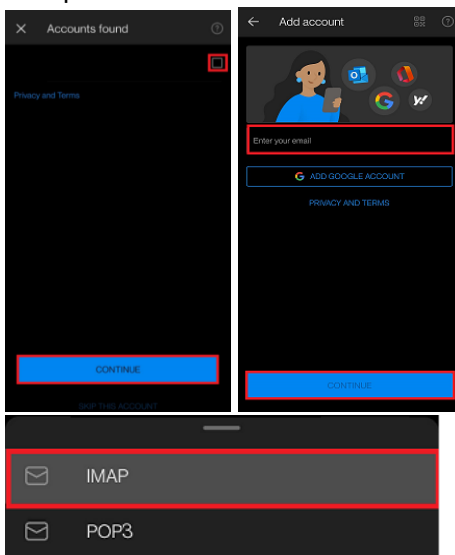


Outlook for Android – Manual setup

2. Untick any accounts found > Tap “Continue” > Enter your email address > Tap “Continue” > Tap “IMAP”.




